Due to increased cyber security threats, careers in the cyber security field are in high demand. This has created a shortage of qualified professionals that have the skills to combat these threats.

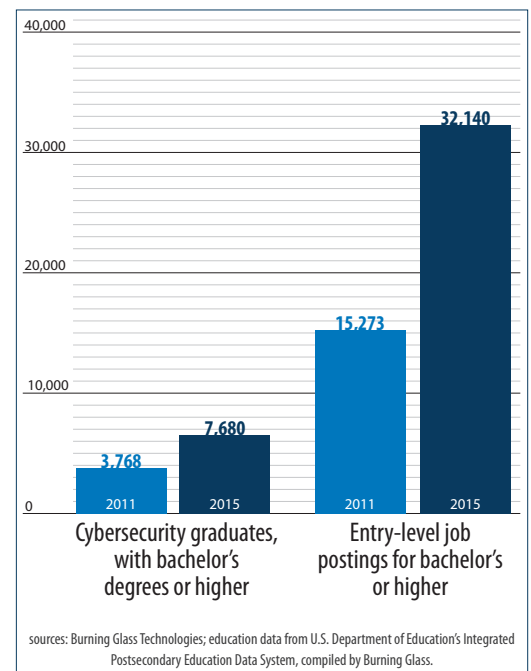

Who should attend?

The MBA with Cyber Security focus is designed for individuals with an IT background who are interested in joining the growing field of cyber security.

Admission Requirements

- GMAT/GRE scores are not required.
- A bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA in your last 90 hours of course work. A 2.5 GPA with 5 years of work experience may be considered.
- Minimum of 5 years of professional work experience

Fees

- \$750.00 per unit or \$3,000.00 per course.
- The fees do not include the cost of textbooks.

Financial Aid

- All applicants must maintain satisfactory progress.
- Graduate students must be conditionally or fully classified in a graduate program.
- Students taking prerequisite courses under the direction of a graduate program in preparation for entrance are eligible for one year of loans.

The Financial Aid Office offers information on Federal Loans, Grants, Federal Work Study Programs and Scholarships. The first step in applying for any type of financial aid (including loans) is to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Students may apply online at the FAFSA website at fafsa.ed.gov. Students seeking financial aid are encouraged to visit the CSUSB Financial Aid Office website at finaid.csusb.edu.

Getting Started

- Two intakes, fall & spring. Please submit the Preliminary Application on our website. Upon submission, you will receive an email from our staff with the next appropriate steps to complete the process.
- International students please note: The program is offered fully online and will not meet requirements for F-1 students.

Please be aware that during the application process you will be required to submit the following:

- Official Transcripts
- Resumé
- Statement of Purpose (250 words)
- Three Letters of Recommendation

Program Overview

Program is completely online and consists of 15 courses (60 units).

Students are expected to complete online MBA Business Boot Camp before the start of their second quarter, unless later completion is approved by the MBA program. Prior to enrolling in each essential class and Advancement to Candidacy, students are required to complete the associated MBA Boot Camp module.

Students normally finish each class in 5 weeks. Each quarter you will take two courses with one course at a time. The program offers a combination of foundation, core and focus courses which are shown below*:
