





Become a school audiometrist, and help identify children with hearing loss

School audiometrists administer tests on students to assess and measure hearing. This online course examines the anatomy and physiology of the auditory mechanism including the nature of the acoustic stimulus, hearing disorders, problems of the hard of hearing, and pure-tone audiometry. The course leads to the Certificate of Registration as a School Audiometrist, granted by the California Department of Health Services, upon successful completion (4 units, quarter system).

How you will benefit:

- Use precision hearing testing equipment, which includes frequent testing for calibration and function.
- Gain knowledge to perform screening and threshold tests.
- Learn to keep accurate records and prepare reports as required or indicated.
