Who Should Attend

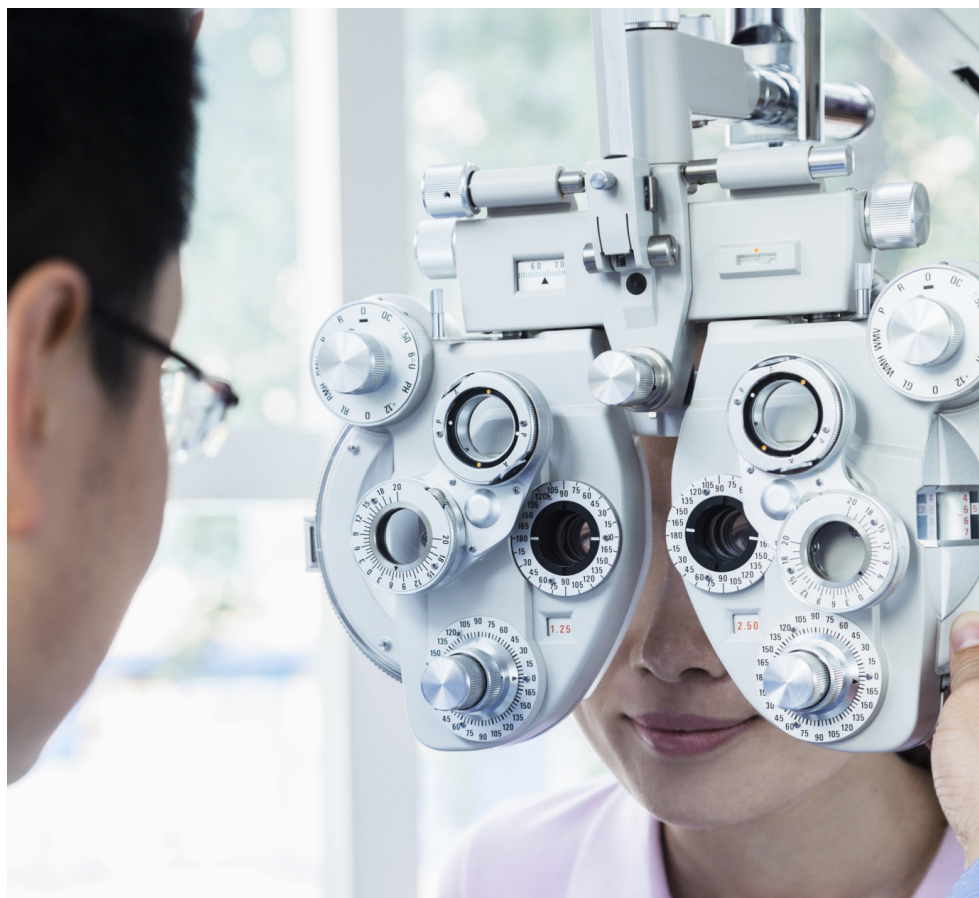
Anyone who wants to begin a career as an optician. You'll have the skills and knowledge you need to advance in this popular and exciting medical field.

Requirements

Must have access to a computer, Internet and an active e-mail account. Adobe Flash Player and Adobe Acrobat Reader are also required for this course.



Certificate Completion

Prepare yourself to achieve American Board of Opticianry (ABO) certification, which is required by many states and is a stepping-stone to career advancement.
